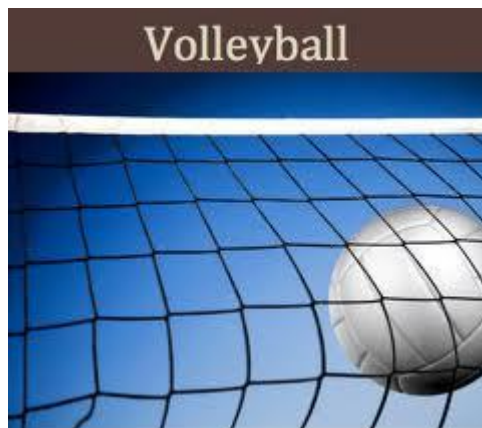

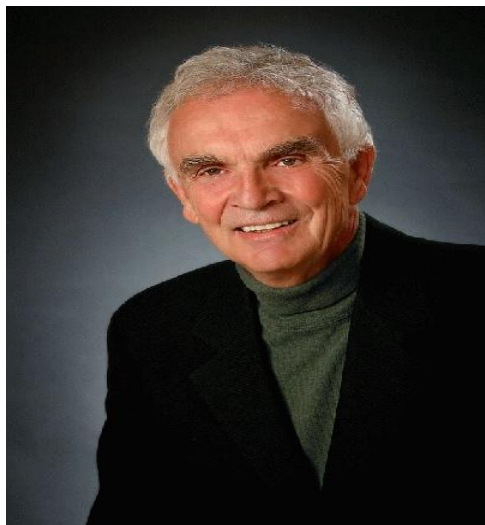
The PEISAA Domino's Midget and Senior basketball leagues are underway and will take a short break over Christmas holiday season before picking up again approaching provincial championships late February.

PEISAA CELEBRATES **50th Anniversary**

Charlie Ballem chaired initial meeting Dec 27, 1961.

A builder is someone who has helped create a sport framework and delivery system with a powerful influence on the people involved in that delivery. Charlie Ballem provided the framework, put in the hours, and set the guidelines for those that came afterwards as a person whose contribution to sport and in particular the PEISAA has been immense.

Born in Mount Albion in 1929, Charlie began teaching at Summerside High School in 1957 where he was an exemplary, award winning physical education teacher and coach of many teams, remembered most for the way he instilled respect in those he taught.

It was Charlie who provided the leadership that developed the PEI School Athletic Association from an idea of a few forward thinking individuals into the successful program that it is now. He was elected as the initial president on Dec 27, 1961 and served in that capacity until 1964. During his tenure as President, Charlie wrote the constitution, by-laws and policy

handbook for the fledgling organization, documents that continue to serve as a reference for operational decisions of the association today.

Charlie continued on the Executive until 1969, later becoming Executive Director of the PEISAA and continued as a consultant in phys ed and recreation.

His innovative leadership moved the sport program into the Elementary and Junior High schools, and by moving into the lower grades, the PEISAA became a complete sport system.

Charlie enforced the professionalization of physical education programs in our province. With assistance from the physical education coordinators, the first official physical education curriculum was developed in the mid 1970s. In recognition for what Charlie Ballem achieved in PEI school sport, the PEISAA presented him with its first builders award in 2000, and then subsequently named the award in his honour. As well, Charlie has been installed as a member of the PEI Sports Hall of Fame.

As part of the PEISAA's celebration of its 50 years of operation, recognition of Charlie Ballem's leadership is essential and the thousands of Island youth involved as school athletes over the years need to be appreciative of his insight.
